Dr. Gabriel Vargas obtained his undergraduate degree from the University of California, Berkeley where he majored in Anthropology & Genetics. He received his MD and PhD degrees from the University of California, Irvine followed by a research-track residency in Psychiatry at the University of California, San Francisco. After a clinical and research fellowship, he joined the faculty at UCSF as an assistant professor in the Psychiatry Department where he spent three years leading a research group.

After leaving academia in 2006, he spent five years at Roche, the last three in Basel, Switzerland as the head of the Neuroscience Clinical Biomarker Group where he worked on molecular and digital biomarkers. He joined Amgen in 2011 and leads a group of physician-scientists in Neuroscience and heads the Digital Health activities in Medical Sciences. He co-leads Amgen’s newly formed Clinical Technology & Experience Lab and has led several digital health studies to test wearable sensors and devices and patient engagement technologies.
