## I.C.E.

is a shadowing program that offers pre-med UCI undergraduate students the unique opportunity to gain a broad perspective of the medical field and its various departments.



## WHY JOIN?

- Explore a career in healthcare
- Shadow medical professionals
- Acquire clinical experience
- Attend grand rounds and medical lectures



## WHO SHOULD APPLY?

- Students at least 18 years of age
- Students currently enrolled at UCI (min. 12 units) with at least 2 quarters completed
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Students with strong communication & interpersonal skills



## EXPECTATIONS

- I.C.E. is a **3 quarter, 100-hour** commitment
- Students will be paired with a new physician on a quarterly basis
- Minimum of three 4-hour long shifts per month, all of which must be completed on weekdays, during regular business hours
- Time and place of shadowing shifts vary, dependent on physicians' schedules
- Students are allowed one 1-month leave of absence, only after completing at least 60 hours of shadowing

## REQUIREMENTS

*following acceptance:*

- Completion of HIPAA paperwork
- Proof of health clearance (TB & Immunization)
- Attend a 2-hour orientation at UCI Medical Center
- Purchase \$25 I.C.E. Button-Up Shirt
- Begin shadowing at the start of the next rotation (determined by UCI quarterly calendar)
